Safe ministry policy

Our Safe ministry policy contains details about the need and requirements for the protection of children and the vulnerable in our parish.

If you work in a parish ministry involving children you will need to comply with requirements for a police check, Working with Children check and attend a Diocesan ChurchSafe workshop.

Lone worker policy

Our lone worker policy is in place to ensure the health and safety of people engaged in parish business when working alone at any time, in any part of the parish's buildings or grounds and off-site.

If you are working alone in a building or the grounds, even if others are working in another part of the site, you are to comply with the requirements set down in the policy for your safety.

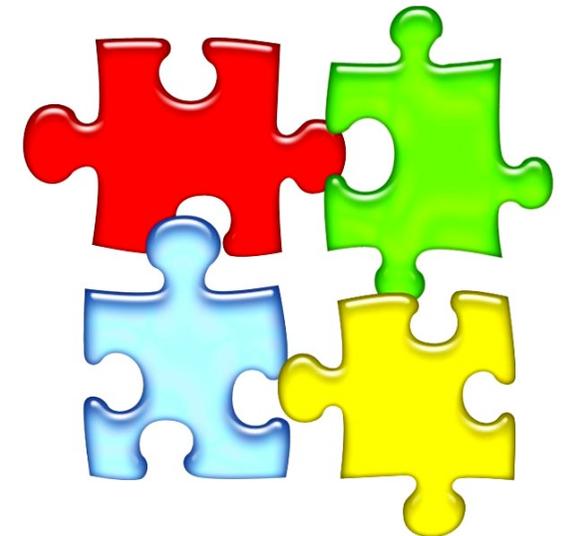
