



COVID-19

This is a time of great uncertainty and anxiety and the parish will continue to keep informed about Government requirements and restrictions and to comply with them, for the safety of parishioners, staff, volunteers and visitors. Due to concerns about the spread of COVID-19 in Australia, the WA Government has delayed its Phase 5 lifting of restrictions a second time. This would have seen the removal of WAs 2sq metre rule and enabled us to all worship at the same service. The new tentative date for Phase 5 is now Saturday 29 August. A final decision on whether Phase 5 can proceed will be made in around a week’s time.

In the meantime, WA is operating under Phase 4 distancing and hygiene restrictions. The parish has a COVID-19 Safety Plan for each of its buildings, restricting the number of people allowed at any one time. Within this, everyone is still required to keep a distance of 1.5m from each other unless a family group. A copy of the COVID-19 Safety Plans are located in each building.



Buildings and common touch surfaces are regularly cleaned and bottles of hand sanitiser are located in every building. Use of hand

sanitiser as you enter a building or area is a condition of entry. Please do not mistake inconvenience for oppression or overkill. If this causes you

concern please discuss with Revd Oliver.

We ask you not to enter parish buildings if you feel unwell. If anyone appears unwell after entering a building, we will ask that you go home until you are well again when we look forward to welcoming you back.

Please advise the parish if you or a person you have been in contact with has tested positive to Covid-19. There are certain actions the parish is legally required to take if this situation occurs, such as advising and working with public health officials, building closure and deep cleaning and contact tracing.

Everyone needs to be aware there are penalties for non-compliance with Government Covid-19 directions including imprisonment and/or fines and these penalties are being enforced. It is important you follow parish distancing and hygiene instructions to comply with Government restrictions.
